

Your guide to the changes for 2021

Following an Ofgual consultation in July 2020, we made changes to a number of our qualifications.

These changes would have applied to the summer 2021 examinations, had they gone ahead. After a further consultation, Ofqual confirmed the changes will now apply to the autumn 2021 examinations.

Please <u>use the specification on our website</u> alongside the information below, which explains how this qualification will differ in autumn 2021.

Overview of changes for GCSE (9–1) History A (Explaining the Modern World)

Ofqual have confirmed that students taking GCSE (9–1) History A (Explaining the Modern World) in Autumn 2021 will not have to study and will not be assessed on all the content of the full course:

- All students will be required to study and will be assessed on the Period study (International Relations).
- Students will study and be assessed on **two** out of the three remaining studies: the **Non-British Depth Study**, the **Thematic Study**, and the **British Depth Study and Study of a Historic Environment**. Centres are free to choose which two of these studies they enter their students for.
- Each study will be assessed separately with its own exam paper in its own timetabled slot.

GCSE(9-1) History A (Explaining the Modern World) for academic year 2020/21

Students must complete the **Period Study (International Relations)** and **two** other studies from a choice of three to be awarded OCR's GCSE (9–1) History A in **Autumn 2021**.

- All of the 2021 question papers will be equally weighted in terms of historical content, before the addition of SPaG marks. The percentages shown above do not take in the ten marks for SPaG on the compulsory **Period Study (International Relations)**.
- We have removed 10 marks from the **Period Study (International Relations)**. Question 4 will be worth 10 marks, not 20. The requirements of the question will remain the same see the revised specimen assessment materials.
- We have added an extra 10 mark question to the **Non-British Depth Study**, with similar requirements to Question 6. See the revised specimen assessment materials.
