

Final arrangements for the 14–19 Diploma

The 14–19 Diploma can be awarded until 31 August 2014. Until this date, candidates who wish to resit qualifications to improve, or to aggregate their Diploma may still do so (see deadline below).

However, it is no longer possible to do this via the Diploma Aggregation Service (DAS).

Instead, centres need to complete the Diploma award form (available on the [JCQ website](#)) and send it to the relevant Diploma Awarding Body (DAB). An exemplar Diploma Award form is also provided to help you.

For candidates registered as OCR DAB candidates, please send completed forms to **priorachievement@ocr.org.uk**. We will need to verify all qualifications listed in the claim so please ensure the details are correct and complete before you submit them.

We will aim to issue Diploma results and certificates within 28 days of receiving the form unless you intend to use results from the January and June 2014 series. In these cases, Diploma results will be issued on the January and June restricted results issue dates (see below), with certificates issued shortly afterwards. Results will be sent via email.

Please note, it is no longer possible to register new Diploma candidates with OCR.
