 - We have been working with Ofqual to confirm the arrangements for Speaking & Listening, following their confirmation that the marks will no longer contribute to the overall grade for GCSEs in English and English Language. We recognise that centres need to make entries and are issuing the basedata now to enable you to do this. Please note that some of the unit entry codes have changed, as detailed in the table below:
