CHANGE OF SET TEXT FOR FIRST EXAMINATION IN JUNE 2016

The texts listed below will be examined for the first time in the June 2016 series. We expect you to start teaching these new texts in September 2015 to candidates taking A2 for the first time in June 2016. These details are also available on pages 49-50 of the GCE Classics specification.

From June 2016, the A2 set texts will be:

- Aristophanes' *Clouds* and *Lysistrata*
- Plautus' *The Brothers Menaechmus* and *The Swaggering Soldier*

Candidates may use any complete translation of the texts. Where a translation is printed on a question paper, it will be taken from:

- Aristophanes, *Lysistrata* and *Clouds* translated by A Sommerstein (Penguin)
- Plautus, *The Swaggering Soldier* and *The Brothers Menaechmus* translated by E F Watling (Penguin).

Extracts printed on the question paper will be taken from these translations even if they go out of print during the lifetime of the specification.
