Question 1 Home and local area**Write about your friends.****Remember:**

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses

You can use your own ideas **or** you could include these ideas:

- 1 say who you are and what friends you have (eg one or two / lots / near your home / at school);
- 2 describe your best friend (eg age / appearance / character);
- 3 describe an activity you have done or that you will do with your friend and how you feel about it;
- 4 say whether you think it is important to have good friends and why;
- 5 say what interesting places in your local area you would show to a friend from Turkey and why.

Question 2 Health and sport**Write about Turkish food.****Remember:**

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses

You can use your own ideas **or** you could include these ideas:

- 1 say who you are and what sort of food you normally eat;
- 2 say where and when you like to eat Turkish food (eg at home / in a restaurant / in Turkey / at weekends);
- 3 describe a special meal you have eaten recently or will eat and how you feel about it;
- 4 say whether you think it is healthy to eat a variety of foods and why;
- 5 say what you would do to encourage someone to try Turkish food for the first time and why.

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Question 3 Leisure and entertainment**Write about special occasions.****Remember:**

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses

You can use your own ideas **or** you could include these ideas:

- 1 say who you are and what you normally do in your free time;
- 2 say what you do at a special occasion, like a birthday party (eg food / music / who with);
- 3 give details of a special occasion that you have been to or plan to go to and how you feel about it;
- 4 say what you think is good about special occasions and why;
- 5 describe what you would do to celebrate your own very special occasion and why.

Question 4 Travel and the wider world**Write about journeys.****Remember:**

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses

You can use your own ideas **or** you could include these ideas:

- 1 say where you normally like to go for a day trip and who you go with;
- 2 give more details of the journey for the day trip you normally like to make (eg transport / how far / what you see);
- 3 describe a **special journey** you have made or one that you plan to make and how you feel about it;
- 4 say what you think is the best way to travel and why;
- 5 say what you would like to do on an exciting journey anywhere in the world and why.

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses

- 2 give details of a job that you often see people or a family member or a friend doing (eg who / what / where);
- 3 describe some work experience that you have had or will have and how you feel about it;
- 4 say whether or not you think it is important to have a job that you like and why;
- 5 say what your ideal job would be and why.
