G353: Introduction to Historical Study in Music

Prescribed Repertoire from June 2013 onwards

A set of prescribed repertoire (which will change from series to series – see below) forms a nucleus of musical material from which candidates should gain specific and contextual knowledge and understanding through listening, study and exploration of the music.

The 18th/early 19th-century Orchestra: Prescribed Orchestral Scores

The scores prescribed for study, and on which assessment *in Sections B and C* will be based in each series, are listed below. Any editions of miniature scores may be used for study purposes.

Candidates are expected to have compared different performance recordings of each item of the prescribed repertoire.

Three scores are prescribed for study in each series, as follows:

June 2014 - June 2015

- Handel: Water Music Suite no.2 in D, HWV349 (Allegro, Alla Hornpipe, Menuet, Lentement & Bourree)
- Mozart: Concerto no.4 in E-flat for horn & orchestra, K.495, 3rd movement
- Beethoven: Symphony no.5 in c, op.67, 1st movement

June 2016 - June 2017

- J.S. Bach: Brandenburg Concerto no.2 in F. BWV 1047, 1st movement
- Mozart: Concerto for piano & orchestra in d, K.466, 1st movement
- Rossini: Overture to "La Gazza Ladra" (The Thieving Magpie)

June 2018 - June 2019

- **Handel**: Organ concerto in B-flat (op.7 no.1), HWV.306, Andante, Andante & Bourrée (Allegro) [**N.B.** the Largo e piano movement is not expected to be covered for this work]
- Havdn: Symphony no.104 in D ("London"). Hob. I: 104. 1st movement
- Schubert: Symphony in B-flat (No.5), D.485, 1st movement
