WITHDRAWAL OF OCR LEVEL 2 PRINCIPAL LEARNING IN ENGINEERING

Following the withdrawal of the Diploma Aggregation Service (DAS) and launch of Cambridge Nationals in Engineering, OCR has decided to withdraw the Level 2 Principal Learning in Engineering. The last full examination series for this qualification will be June 2015, with a re-sit opportunity in January 2016. OCR will of course continue to support and assess the Level 2 Principal Learning in Engineering up to the last certification date.
