This annual prize, for first award in 2016, is open to all students studying the African Kingdoms c.1400-1800 option (Y239) and entering for the AS examination.

The African Kingdoms option is an exciting new addition to A Level History specifications, which we're confident students will find exciting and stimulating (further details here <http://www.ocr.org.uk/qualifications/as-a-level-gce-history-a-h105-h505-from-2015/>). OCR and KCL have worked in collaboration to produce the specification content and support materials. An ebook to support the course will be available for free download from the OCR website later this year, well in advance of first teaching.

Teacher nomination will be a key part of the judging criteria for the prize, which can recognise improvement and effort as well as ability. The prize will be jointly judged and awarded by OCR and KCL.
