An overview of this qualification	<p>This qualification is a vocationally-related, credit-based qualification that provides you with valuable opportunities to develop skills, gain underpinning knowledge and understanding to provide progression to the next level of business and/or business enterprise qualifications.</p> <p>This qualification aims to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • equip you with the ability to consider all aspects of setting up in business from a personal and practical perspective • equip you to consider the potential of your business idea and your own personal needs as a business person working for yourself • ensure you are able to identify any training or personal development that you may require to set up your own business • equip you with the skills to investigate the business idea and start to define a market and customer base. <p>In addition this qualification aims to ensure you have an understanding of some of the more in depth requirements for setting up in business, such as: legal structures and their implications, methods of selling, financial requirements, knowledge of attracting and retaining customers. It also provides you with the tools to draft the basis of a business plan.</p> <p>This qualification includes some mandatory units:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Considering a business idea • Identifying personal development needs to start a business venture • Identifying the resources and location for a business venture. <p>The remaining units are optional and cover a range of topics including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attracting customers through marketing • Investing legal issues relating to a business venture • Planning the financial management of a business venture etc. <p>Assessment takes the form of an OCR set assignment for each unit, which ensures coverage of all of the required knowledge, skills and understanding and allows you to build a portfolio of evidence.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The minimum amount of vocational learning = 15 credits • The maximum amount of vocational learning = 15 credits
