- (a)** How does Sophocles bring out Oedipus' self-disgust in Passage 2A? [25]
- (b)** 'Oedipus is so hot-tempered and so offensive towards other characters that it is difficult to feel much sympathy for him.' Do you agree? In your answer you should refer both to Passage 2B and to the rest of the play. [25]

- (a)** Show how, in Passage 3A, Aristophanes derives humour from the way in which he portrays Socrates and the students. [25]
- (b)** 'Throughout the *Clouds*, Aristophanes argues for the superiority of the old over the new.' Do you agree? In your answer you should refer both to Passage 3B and to the rest of the play. [25]
