

New! Extended awards are now approved for funding

The extended awards form part of a suite of Cambridge Progression qualifications in Mathematics and English, and are for learners to build underpinning skills in Mathematics and English which provide a 'stepping stone' to study these subjects at a higher level.

The DFE have approved the following as 'stepping stone' qualifications for teaching under the 16-19 English and maths condition of funding:

- 601/5858/X OCR Entry Level Cambridge Extended Award in Skills to Underpin English (Entry 1)
- 601/5859/1 OCR Entry Level Cambridge Extended Award in Skills to Underpin English (Entry 2)
- 601/5860/8 OCR Entry Level Cambridge Extended Award in Skills to Underpin English (Entry 3)
- 601/5861/X OCR Level 1 Cambridge Extended Award in Skills to Underpin English - (achievement requires a minimum of 2 units of which at least one must be externally assessed)

- 601/5853/0 OCR Entry Level Cambridge Extended Award in Skills to Underpin Mathematics (Entry 1)
- 601/5854/2 OCR Entry Level Cambridge Extended Award in Skills to Underpin Mathematics (Entry 2)
- 601/5855/4 OCR Entry Level Cambridge Extended Award in Skills to Underpin Mathematics (Entry 3)
- 601/5856/6 OCR Level 1 Cambridge Extended Award in Skills to Underpin Mathematics (of which all units are externally assessed)
