- OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technical Extended Certificate in IT (601/7098/0)

I am happy now to support these qualifications for recognition as Applied General qualifications on the basis that the learning provided by the units will provide a strong base of knowledge and skills from which a student, including these qualifications within an appropriate programme of study, could progress into higher education. I am particularly pleased to note the inclusion of Security as a core module, a move which is important both in terms of the National agenda and in terms of producing well-rounded computer professionals, who look at both sides of every technology.

Admission decisions at the University of Bath are centralised, with subject input of course, and I would certainly be happy to recommend that the Extended Certificate be considered as a relevant qualification for entry into our courses in Computer Science (including the "with Business" option) at the University of Bath. The central office does not currently consider A/S levels, but should this policy change, I would recommend the Certificate on the same basis.
