INTRODUCTION

Facework is a resource developed by Inclusion Trust in partnership with Stephen Carrick Davies and funded by Nominet Trust. The resource encourages young people to reflect on their own experiences and attitudes to employment and learn through teaching their peers.

Facework challenges young people to radically 'flip their thinking' about the attitudes needed to thrive in today's world of work via videos, social media, quizzes and 25 unique employability challenges. These resources were co-designed by young people learning outside of mainstream schools in Alternative Education Settings. The Facework Challenges are free and can be downloaded from www.facework.today. They tackle everyday practical activities which young people will need to master in preparation for entering employment. They encourage learners to engage in writing, talking, researching, drawing, role-play and face to face contact with employers. They are suitable for a wide variety of pre-employability programmes.
