Ref: Changes to the Level 5 Diploma in Teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector Qualification

When you register candidates for the new Level 5 Diploma in Teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector (10173), a Candidate Record Form will no longer be sent to your centre to claim units for candidates. Instead, you will need to log on to OCR's Interchange site and claim the units for each candidate. A candidate submission sheet will need to be completed when submitting any units and this will be loaded on to the OCR website shortly.

Also, the following 4 units are now level 5 and not level 4 as in the previous 06756 qualification:

- Unit 16 Enabling learning and assessment
- Unit 33 Numeracy and the learners
- Unit 40 Literacy and the learners
- Unit 43 Literacy, ESOL and the learners.
