












Migration Support Guide

The new qualification follows on from the previous qualifications by developing the best and most successful parts of each of the previous qualifications.

Unit B061 – builds upon the success of Unit 2357 from OCR ICT A

Unit B062 – builds upon the success of Unit 2358 in ICT A and takes the form of a structured task. The unit also utilises a banded mark scheme which has been successfully utilised in Unit 2378 ICT B.

Unit B063 – Builds upon the success of the research-led Unit 2379 in ICT B to allow for future developments in ICT use. It also builds upon Unit One extending student knowledge.

Unit B064 – Builds upon the success of Unit 2360 ICT A, but follows a set context approach successfully utilised in Unit 2379 ICT B. The unit also utilises a banded mark scheme.
