



What stays the same

- OCR set and marked assignments
- On-demand assignments can be scheduled at centre/learner convenience
- Skills-based units split between manual and computerised
- Many new units similar to old OCR units
- Entry on unit or full qualification basis
- Entry via named or unnamed route
- Assessment approach remains the same ie fault tolerance based marking

What's different

- Revised qualifications based on new common QCF units (credit-rated and transferable)
- Unit content developed jointly with other awarding bodies and supported by FSSC
- No timetabled examination for any unit
- Brand new units eg M1 and M3 at Level 1
- New assessment duration for units eg 45 mins for Level 1 manual units
- Answer books unique for each assignment
- CSV files downloadable from OCR Interchange (no CD)
- Assignments and answer books downloadable from OCR Interchange
- E-claims system for claiming candidate achievement
- Submission of candidate work with Submission Cover Sheet
