

Expected Duration:

Approx. 10 – 20 minutes

Introduction to Images is a drag and drop activity which is a short introduction to image adjustment effects. Students are shown a series of copies of an image. Each one has had a particular effect applied to it. Students must match the image to the name of the effect that has been applied to it.

Preparation:

There is little or no preparation for this task.

The Activity:

Students can work alone or in pairs.

Students look at 12 images and trying to match the applied effect to its name.

The 12 effects are:

- Effect 1: **Emboss**
- Effect 2: **Increased Red Colour Balance**
- Effect 3: **Tiles**
- Effect 4: **Greyscale**

Effect 5:	<i>Blur</i>
Effect 6:	<i>Pixelate</i>
Effect 7:	<i>Find Edges</i>
Effect 8:	<i>Increased Brightness</i>
Effect 9:	<i>Motion Blur</i>
Effect 10:	<i>Increased Colour Saturation</i>
Effect 11:	<i>Invert</i>
Effect 12:	<i>Cutout</i>

These effects were applied in Photoshop using standard adjustments and filters.
