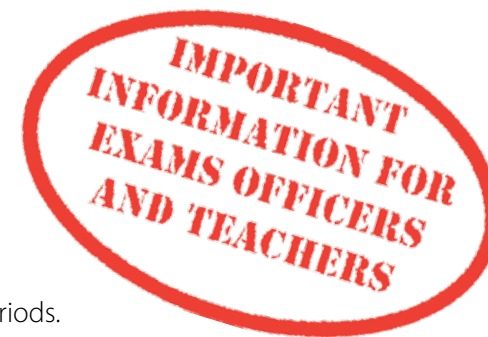




Results Hot Tips



Interchange offers a full range of online results and post-results services to help you make the most of your time during the busy results periods. To make sure your centre and candidates benefit fully from these services, please take the time to read the information below.

Results

Provisional results are released to centres via Interchange and EDI, and via A2C (for those centres which have already migrated to the new standard), on the restricted results release day and can be released to candidates from 06:00 the following day.

Results data, documents and reports – You can view all your centre results on [Interchange](#), filtering and sorting data by candidate or subject to display both unit and full award information. In addition, you will be able to generate a variety of results documents, including statements of results and results broadsheets.

NEW from the January 2012 series, **all results documents** will be available electronically, via Interchange. To make sure you're aware and can make the most of the information that will be available, here's a summary of what you can expect to find on Interchange on the restricted results release date on 7 March 2012:

- **Results and grade thresholds report** – This replaces the specification results and grade thresholds and unit results reports. Combining and expanding on the information included in these reports, this shows results for linear specifications and **all units**.
- **Results broadsheet**
- **Moderation adjustments report**
- **Cumulative specification results report**
- **Statement of results**
- **Report to a centre on moderated work** – This will be available electronically, via Interchange, for the majority of subjects. For certain subjects, however, this will still be issued in hard copy for the January 2012 series. See the [exceptions list](#) on the OCR website to find out more.

Grade boundaries – Available from the [results statistics page](#) on restricted results release day, you can find the raw mark and UMS grade boundaries at unit level for all specifications. For the January and June 2012 series, the 90 per cent conversion points used in the calculation of the A* grade for all A2 units will also be available.

Provisional exam statistics will be made available on the [results statistics page](#) on the candidate release date (for January and June 2012 only). This provides the cumulative number and percentage of candidates achieving each grade, for all specifications.

Active Results

[Active Results](#) is our free, online results analysis service designed to help teachers review the performance of both individual candidates and whole schools. The service is available from the candidate release date to all Interchange users with the Tutor/Teacher role.
