

Checking entries for C7 F 'GCE Mathematics

You are strongly advised to re-enter for any certifications which were entered in any previous series. This prevents several possible problems with entries and ensures that the best combination of grades is awarded. This particularly applies to any candidate entering for Further Mathematics, AS or A Level. **The following steps assume that you have done this.**

Using the tables below, look up the combination of certifications being entered and check that the correct number of unit entries have been made, that the mandatory unit entries have been made and that a valid combination exists for each candidate.

GCE Mathematics (unit codes are provided on page 45 of the GCE Entry Codes section of the OCR *Admin Guide*)

Further Maths only	3892 7892	To enter for Further Maths, a candidate must certificate or have certificated for Maths. If this is from a different specification or awarding body then a manual certification form must be completed. See the OCR <i>Admin Guide Entry Codes</i> , page 47, note z.
