1. What are the QCF Qualification Numbers (QN) for the OCR Retail Knowledge qualifications?

2. What is the **difference** between the Level 2 Award/Certificate in Retail Knowledge (**01766/01767**) and the Level 2 Award/Certificate in Retail Knowledge (**10360/10361**)?

These qualifications contain the same units but have different assessment models. Schemes **01766** and **01767** are assessed via on-line multiple choice tests and schemes **10360** and **10361** are assessed via the completion of evidence booklets which are internally assessed and externally moderated.

3. I have a candidate who is working towards their Level 2 Certificate in Retail Knowledge and has achieved 10 credits via the completion of on-line tests on scheme 01767. Is this candidate able to achieve their remaining 4 credits via the completion of evidence booklets on scheme 10361?

Yes, candidates can achieve the full Level 2 Award/Certificate via on-line multiple choice tests **and/or** via the completion of evidence booklets.

4. My centre is approved to run the Level 2 Award and Certificate in Retail Knowledge (01766 and 01767). How do I get approval to run the moderated model (10360 and 10361)?

There will be an automatic addition of centre approval for schemes 10360 and 10361 for active centres. Active centres are defined by any or all of the following criteria:

- Registered candidates in the last 24 months
- Claimed certificates in the last 12 months
- Gained centre approval in the last 12 months but not yet registered candidates

6. For schemes 10360 and 10361, do we have to use the OCR candidate evidence booklets?

OCR provides candidate evidence booklets for each unit which aim to help support candidates through the process of collecting appropriate evidence. Their use is not mandatory, and centres wishing to adapt them or use their own materials are welcome to do so, provided they ensure the evidence submitted meets the assessment criteria. An evidence checklist is available for each unit for those centres not using the evidence booklets.
