Subject: Live Assignments for Creative iMedia Levels 1, 2 and 3

LIVE ASSIGNMENTS FOR CREATIVE IMEDIA LEVELS 1, 2 AND 3 (ENTRY CODES 04304–04312)

All OCR live assignments for the Creative iMedia suite Levels 1–3 have been reviewed. This is to ensure that the assignment tasks are consistent with the full range of assessment criteria for each unit.

Please note that for all future submissions, **the updated assignments must be used** and centres must destroy copies of the previous versions.

Changes are as follows:

Level 3 live assignments: In general, many of these had an extra task in the evaluation section. This required learners to *'Provide an explanatory narrative on the creation process, identifying for example key stages, tools and techniques used'*. This is not a separate assessment criterion in any unit and therefore it has been removed. In a similar way, several units were asking for slightly more in the tasks than was required by the assessment criteria – these too have been amended.

Important information about Units 304 and 305

Unit 304: There have been changes made to the OCR live assignment for Unit 304. A version had been available on OCR Interchange where there was an inconsistency against the criteria that related to Learning Outcome 1 and 2. This version has now been replaced in OCR Interchange with an amended assignment.

Unit 305: The assessment criteria for 4.3 and 4.4 for Unit 305 refer to a 3D character. The learning outcome is in the context of evaluating the 3D effects against a client brief for sound effects – so 3D characters are for sound. This version has now been replaced in OCR Interchange with an amended assignment, reflecting that the assessment criteria concerns 3D sound.

If your candidates are part way through an assignment, you must make sure their evidence meets the assessment criteria in the unit (please note our instruction about Unit 305 above). Where centres create their own assignments, it is the centres' responsibility to ensure that their assignments still meet the requirements of the assessment criteria or learners are at risk of not evidencing the unit fully.
