- 4 Olaf is determined to ensure that all of the larger vehicles that may be bought in future are suitable for the carriage of all passengers with disabilities. Olaf has asked you to provide some general guidance about specifications for these vehicles.

For each of the following, outline **TWO** features that OCR should ensure are in place.

c) State **THREE** forms of evidence which may be given as proof of 'Financial Standing'.

d) State **THREE** requirements that only an External Transport Manager must meet. DO NOT include any requirements that also apply to Internal Transport Managers.

6 The brothers believe that they are currently exempt from Driver CPC requirements as they work for the welfare of the community.

Give **FOUR** situations in which a driver employed by OCR would be exempt from the requirement to hold a valid Driver Qualification Card.
