
We believe a student who achieves one of the following qualifications should be effectively prepared for related jobs, apprenticeships, training or higher education courses:

600/4221/7 OCR Level 2 Cambridge technical Diploma in Health and Social Care (QCF)
600/4224/2 OCR Level 2 Cambridge technical Extended Certificate in Health and Social Care (QCF)
