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Adventure Breaks and Activities

Situation:

OCR Adventure Breaks is an outdoor adventure activity company providing a range of activities for individuals, families, school and community groups. The company provide activities including:

- climbing
- abseiling
- canoeing
- white water rafting
- bush craft and survival
- mountain biking
- paintballing.

From the list of challenges below select **one** challenge for which you will design and make a model/prototype solution.

Challenge 1 ‘Promotional Material’

There are many companies offering similar activity breaks. OCR Adventure Breaks requires three dimensional (3D) promotional material that will make them more appealing than other adventure companies. The promotional material will be displayed at places such as youth clubs, schools and community centres.

Challenge 2 ‘Camping Food’

Participants in overnight activities require a healthy and balanced hot meal. A meal kit is to be provided. The meal should be easily carried and cooked by the individual undertaking the activity.

Challenge 3 ‘Overnight Shelter’

A portable shelter is required for use by individuals undertaking the bush craft and survival overnight activity. The shelter should be easily carried.

Challenge 4 ‘Day Bag’

Each individual taking part in the adventure activities will be given a day bag to use to carry their essential equipment such as food, water, first aid, and spare clothing. A suitable day bag is required.



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
