Thank you for inviting me to review your new Cambridge Technicals in Health and Social Care with a view to supporting these as Applied General Qualifications designed for those wishing to progress into Higher Education. The qualifications I have reviewed are:

- OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technical Extended Certificate in Health and Social Care (601/7060/8)
- OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technical Foundation Diploma in Health and Social Care (601/7061/X)
- OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technical Diploma in Health and Social Care (601/7062/1)

I agree that these provide the basis for progression on to a range of HE courses at York College, particularly where they are taken within a programme of study which develops other skills and knowledge at the same level.
