Important information and action regarding the future delivery of *ICT Qualifications* linked to the Ministry of Justice contract

As you may be aware, OCR (Oxford Cambridge and RSA) was successful in its bid to the Ministry of Justice (MoJ) to be the **exclusive** provider of Information Communication Technology (ICT) qualifications for adult learners in England's prisons from August 2018.

Centres providing prison education will be able to choose from OCR's Entry Level to Level 3 qualification range, which includes Functional Skills, IT User Skills (ITQ), Cambridge Technicals, GCSEs and A Levels. This offers both vocational and academic options to suit all learners.
