ExamBuilder

ExamBuilder is a user-friendly package in which you can design your own bespoke exams and tests using a library of exam questions from OCR past papers. You can select topics for assessment and part or full exam questions to test your students' understanding of the subject against genuine exam questions. Putting together a test takes minutes and they can be printed with your school's logo on an exam style front sheet.

Cambridge National Level 1/2 Creative iMedia

Hodder Education provide an OCR endorsed student textbook for Creative iMedia, this is available in [printed](#) and online eTextbook format to meet your student's needs; the eTextbook is available on a 30 day free trial.

Cambridge National Level 1/2 Creative iMedia Dynamic Learning Package

This package provides [a comprehensive set of lesson resources](#) for every module within the creative iMedia suite, similar in many aspects to the teacher delivery packs provided for the OCR GCSE computer science, these resources could save time and effort creating lesson plans, interactive resources and self-marking tests. There is a free 30 day trial available, and there are two annual licence versions which cost £80 for centres of up to 900 students and £120 for more than 900 students, other pricing options are available.

PG Online

PG Online has produced a set of [OCR endorsed lesson resources for units R081 and R082](#) of the Creative iMedia specification. Split into four packs covering the two core units of the course, these include lesson plans, presentations, in-class and homework activities as well as end of unit tests. These resources, which are similar to the teacher delivery packs provided by OCR for the OCR GCSE computer science, could save time and effort creating lessons materials allowing you to focus on your students. Free lessons are available for evaluation and the four packs are priced at £120 each.
