Putting together a test takes minutes and they can be printed with your school or college's logo on an exam style front sheet.

ExamBuilder is free for all OCR centres with an Interchange account and gives you unlimited users per centre.

These <u>digital resources</u> are now available to all OCR teachers free of charge. Resource Plus gives you access to high quality videos, ready-made lesson plans and teaching materials that you can use to help your students learn and prepare for their exams. We also offer Resource Plus materials that are designed for you to share with your students.

Cambridge International resources are written and designed to work alongside IGCSE specifications. There are some very good topic resources which you may find useful when delivering Cambridge Technicals in Business Level 3 05834-05837, 05878. Examples of topic questions which can be used to assess knowledge on areas such as ownership and liability, these contextual tests mean learners will need to make a decision and justify their choices.

<u>Cambridge Technicals Level 3 Business</u>. The official text book is written to run alongside the qualification and will cover whichever pathway you are running in your centre. A free 'e inspection' copy is available to view the content of the text book before purchase. The regular price is £26.99.

Whiteboard e Textbook is available as a teacher's alternative to the paperback version. You can use this to project the book onto the board and edit parts of the textbook in class. There is a no obligation 30 day free trial of this resource and then it is available from £50 after the trial period ends.

Student e Textbook Instead of purchasing a physical copy of the text book, students can have access to an online version from only £6.75 per student. This also comes with a free 30 day trial.
