


## Reduction in the number of assessments for 2021/22

With the approval of the DfE, we are allowing the number of assessments of Cambridge Nationals moderated units to be reduced in 2021/22 where disruption to teaching and learning has been so great that it is necessary. This reduction is only available for those units that were planned to be assessed in 2021/22. Details of the reduction available for each qualification can be found on our [online support centre](#).

A new 'reduction in assessment' area of Interchange will be available after Easter 2022 for you to tell us which units you are using the reduction in assessment for. We will also ask you to upload a simple Head of Centre declaration to confirm the requirements have been followed. The window to submit this information to us is **22 April to 15 May 2022**. The process you follow depends on when the student is due to complete the course (certificate):

### Students certificating in June 2022 For example Year 11/Year 12 in Northern Ireland

	<b>2 Submit a declaration by your Head of Centre or senior leadership member</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>From 22 April 2022, you can access the reduction in assessment area to download the declaration</li><li>Upload the declaration by <b>15 May 2022</b></li><li>The same declaration will cover students certificating in June 2022 and those that are certificating after June 2022. You do not need to submit another declaration next year</li></ul>			<b>5 We will issue results</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>We will produce an <a href="#">assessed grade</a> and assign a uniform mark (UMS) to the unit that is the middle of the range for the grade</li><li>The <a href="#">overall grade</a> will be determined by adding together the uniform marks (UMS) for the units taken and the assessed grade</li></ul>
