The reports will also explain aspects which caused difficulty and why the difficulties arose, whether through a lack of knowledge, poor examination technique, or any other identifiable and explainable reason.

Where overall performance on a question/question part was considered good, with no particular areas to highlight, these questions have not been included in the report.

Unit CC series overview

A significant increase of entries than previous years for the Cloud Technology test taken in January 2022. This appears to be following a pattern of main entries for this unit, taking place in the January series.

Candidates who did well on this paper generally did the following:

Correctly answered questions for the following teaching content:

- 1.2 Cloud Models e.g. Private, Public, Hybrid, Community, Functionality, Location, Technical differences
- 1.5 Organisational Roles and Responsibilities when using Cloud Technology
- 2.4 Business benefits of service models
- 3.3 Organisations' internal skills requirements to support their cloud model
- 3.4 Technology that make cloud services possible
- 4.3 Permission levels.

Candidates who did less well on this paper generally did the following:

Teaching content candidates found challenging:

- 2.1 Similarities & Differences between Outsourcing & Cloud Technology
- 3.2 Accountabilities & Responsibilities based on cloud service model
- 3.4 Technology that make cloud services possible
- 5.2 Cloud readiness assessment e.g. pilot
- 5.3 Role of IT department when choosing cloud services, e.g. Advise.

General comments on the paper

The scope of learning outcomes within this unit and the breadth of knowledge required has meant that some learning outcomes (LOs) were better understood than others. Based on the statistics for the individual items in the Cloud Technology multiple choice test, candidates overall were most successful answering questions targeting LO1: Understand the characteristics and context of cloud technology and why it is used and LO4: Understand the features of cloud storage. Candidates found the following, LO2: Understand the business benefits of cloud services, LO3: Understand the requirements of cloud services and LO5: Understand the deployment requirements for cloud-based services for organisations, the hardest to answer.

Learning outcome 1: questions 1-11, 13-16

This LO requires candidates to understand the characteristics and context of cloud technology and why it is used. Questions targeting this LO had a mixed response, with many candidates achieving the marks on Questions 2, 5 and 10 and very few candidates achieving the marks for Questions 7 and 9. In particular, Questions 4 and 11 were challenging for students.

Learning outcome 2: questions 17 - 28

LO2 requires candidates to understand the business benefits of cloud services. Candidates did well on Question 28 but found 18, 21 and 26 challenging.

Learning outcome 3: questions 29 – 47

LO3 requires candidates to understand the requirements of cloud services. Questions for this learning outcome that presented difficulties for candidates were Questions 34, 35, 37, 42 and 45. Question 43 and 41, most candidates achieved the marks.

Learning outcome 4: questions 48 - 54

LO4 requires candidates to understand the features of cloud storage. There were 7 questions which addressed this learning outcome. Responses to Questions 49 and 50 were the weakest.

Learning outcome 5: questions 55-65

This LO requires candidates to understand the deployment requirements for cloud-based services for organisations. Questions 55, 60, 62 and 63 were answered well with Questions 58, 59 and 61 being less successful.

Learning outcome 6: questions 66 - 67

LO6 requires candidates to know the regulatory issues that impact cloud technology. There were just two questions targeting this learning outcome. Responses to Questions 66 and 67 were often incorrectly answered.

Learning outcome 7: questions 12, 68 - 70

LO7 requires candidates to know about impact, risks and security issues related to cloud technology. Of the 4 questions addressing this learning outcome, learners were most successful with Question 12 and a large majority were unsuccessful with Questions 68, 69 and 70.






