Summer 2024 timeline

We're committed to working with schools and colleges to make sure all students receive their Cambridge Technicals results as planned this summer. This timeline highlights the key dates and deadlines for both the 2012 and 2016 suites – this year, we are making it easier to identify and resolve issues for students. 1–21 March	Schools and colleges make entries for Cambridge Technicals examined units (June 2024 series)
13 March	Release of results for January 2024 series
	Qualification results released to schools and colleges alongside results for January 2024 examined units. Results can be issued to students as soon as they are released.
18 March-	Amend estimated completion dates
30 April	We are introducing an estimated completion date based on the date you made your qualification entries.
	Schools and colleges use the Cambridge Technicals Progress Tracker to amend estimated completion dates for students not following a one-year (Level 2) or two-year (Level 3) course, or who have been registered after the start of the course.
30 April	TERM-TIME CHECKPOINT: Deadline to submit estimated completion date declaration
	Schools and colleges must submit a declaration to confirm all the estimated completion dates are correct. This is the term-time checkpoint.
	The Cambridge Technicals Progress Tracker will be available from March 2024 to submit the declaration.
From 1 May	Schools and colleges check unit achievements are on track and resolve issues
onwards	Schools and colleges will use the Cambridge Technicals Progress Tracker to identify students who are not eligible to receive a result based on the current achievements. This will allow potential issues to be identified and resolved where possible.
	Students without the required unit achievements will not receive a result by results day.
15 May	Deadline for schools and colleges to arrange final planned moderation visit to make sure this takes place before 30 June
	Moderation visits after 30 June may mean that units and related qualification achievements are not available by results day .
15 June d	Schools and colleges to submit claims before moderation visit
	Claims must be submitted at least two weeks before the moderation visit takes place. Students without claims will show as ineligible within the Progress Tracker.
	If claims are submitted later than 15 June, you will have less time to identify and resolve issues and may mean units and related qualification achievements are not available by results day .
30 June d	Final moderation visits to centres completed
	Moderation visits after 30 June may mean that students will not receive unit achievements and related qualification results by results day.
12 August	Release of results for June 2024 series
	Qualification results issued to schools and colleges alongside results for June 2024 series examined units.
	Results can be issued to students as soon as they are released although schools and colleges may wish to issue them at the same time as A Level results.
15 August	Results day
	The day when students will expect to receive their qualification results alongside results for the June 2024 series examined units.
