The reports will include a general commentary on candidates' performance, identify technical aspects examined in the questions and highlight good performance and where performance could be improved. The reports will also explain aspects which caused difficulty and why the difficulties arose, whether through a lack of knowledge, poor examination technique, or any other identifiable and explainable reason.

Where overall performance on a question/question part was considered good, with no particular areas to highlight, these questions have not been included in the report.

## General comments on the paper

The scope of learning outcomes within this unit and the breadth of knowledge required has meant that some learning outcomes (LOs) were better understood than others.

Based on the statistics for the individual items in the Cloud Technology multiple choice test, candidates overall were most successful answering questions targeting LO1: Understand the characteristics and context of cloud technology and why it is used. Candidates found LO3: Understand the requirements of cloud services the hardest.

## Learning outcome 1: questions 1-16

This LO requires candidates to understand the characteristics and context of cloud technology and why it is used. Questions targeting this LO had a good response, with many candidates achieving the marks on questions 1-3, 6, 8-13, 15 and very few candidates achieved marks for question 7, 14 and 16. In particular, students found Question 4 challenging.

## Learning outcome 2: questions 17-28

LO2 requires candidates to understand the business benefits of cloud services. Candidates did well on questions 17, 21-22, 25-26 for this LO particularly question 20 and 24, but found questions 18, 19, 23, 27 and 28 challenging.

## Learning outcome 3: questions 29-47, 70

LO3 requires candidates to understand the requirements of cloud services. Questions 30, 32, 34-35, 41 and 46 presented difficulties for candidates. Candidates did well on questions 31, 39, 42, 44-45 and 70.

## Learning outcome 4: questions 48-52

LO4 requires candidates to understand the features of cloud storage. There were five questions which addressed this learning outcome. Responses to question 52 were the weakest.

## Learning outcome 5: questions 53-62

This LO requires candidates to understand the deployment requirements for cloud-based services for organisations. Questions 54, 57 and 62 were answered well with questions 56 and 58 being less successful.

## Learning outcome 6: questions 63-65

LO6 requires candidates to know the regulatory issues that impact cloud technology. There were three questions which targeted this learning outcome. All candidates received a mark for question 64 as the options were labelled as 1 and 6 rather than 1 and 5. Question 63 and 65 were successfully answered.

## Learning outcome 7: questions 66-69

LO7 requires candidates to know about impact, risks and security issues related to cloud technology. Of the four questions addressing this learning outcome, candidates were most successful with question 66 and 68.






