Map of the UK showing relief

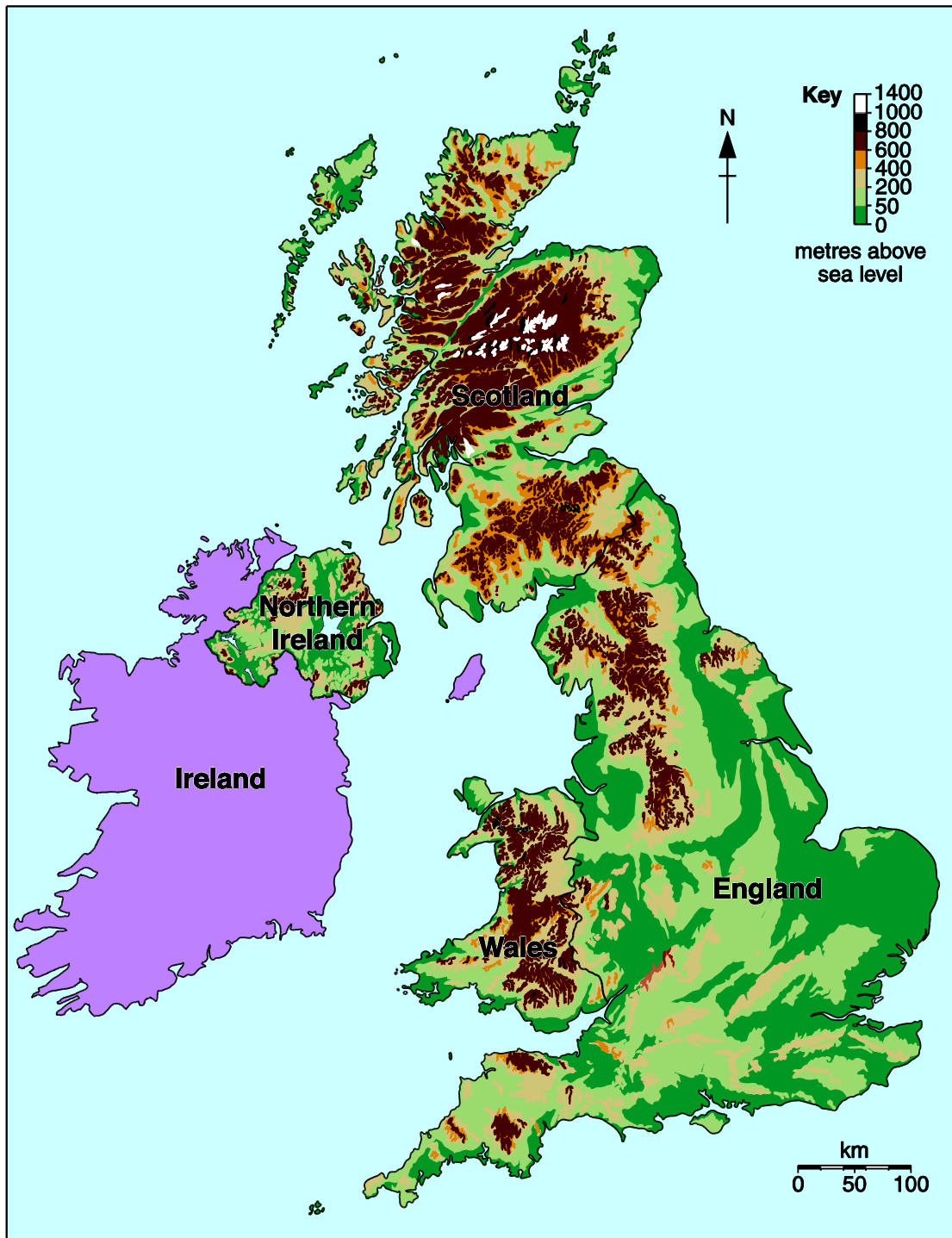

Map of the UK showing population density

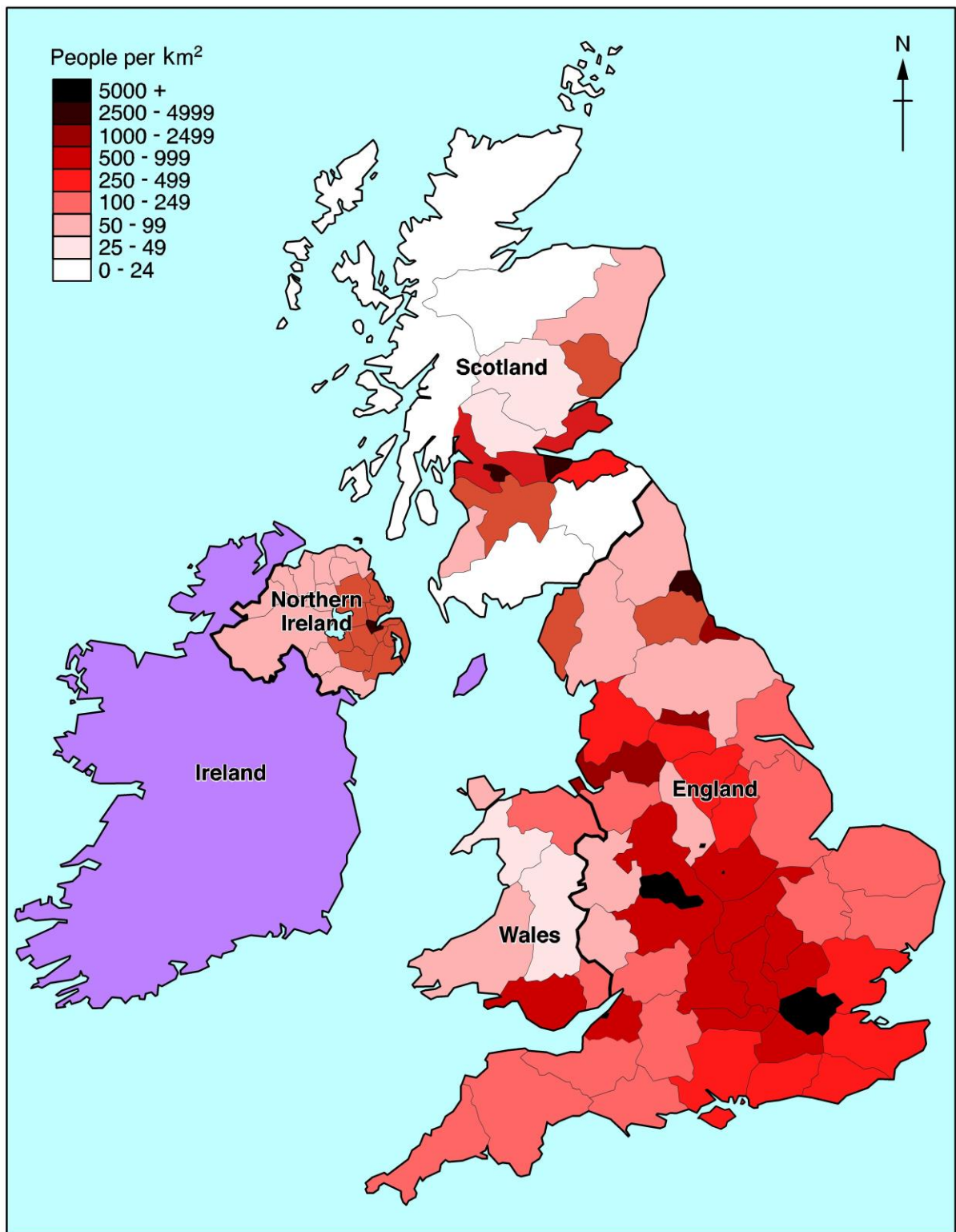
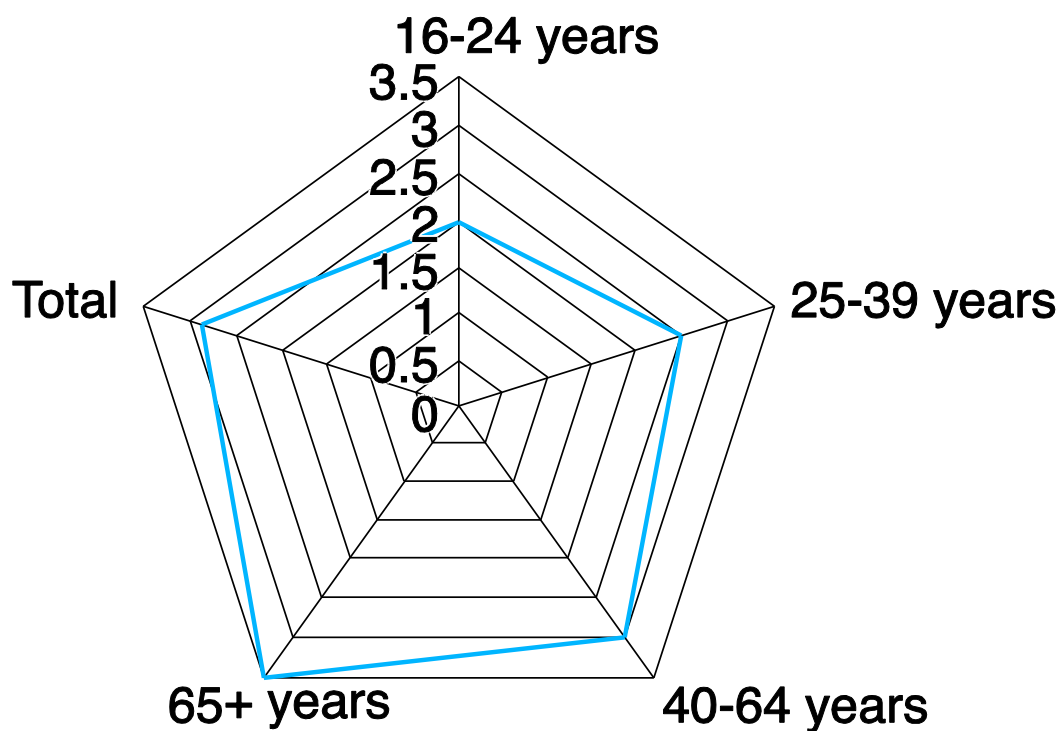
