

Cambridge Technicals Summer 2026 timeline

September onwards	<p>Schools and colleges make entries (registrations) for Cambridge Technicals qualifications</p> <p>Qualification entries are usually made in the first year of study and must be made before examined unit entries can be made or claims are submitted.</p>
September onwards	<p>Make sure estimated completion dates are up to date</p> <p>The estimated completion date is based on the date you made your qualification entries. Schools and colleges use the Cambridge Technicals Progress Tracker to amend estimated completion dates for students not following a one-year (Level 2) or two-year (Level 3).</p>
21 October	<p>Deadline to make entries for Cambridge Technicals examined units (January 2026 series)</p> <p>The entries window opens on 1 October.</p>
11 March	<p>Release of examined unit results for January 2026 series</p> <p>Qualification results released to schools and colleges alongside results for January 2026 examined units. Results can be issued to students as soon as they are released.</p>
21 March	<p>Deadline to make entries for Cambridge Technicals examined units (June 2026 series)</p> <p>The entries window opens on 1 March.</p>
30 April	<p>TERM-TIME CHECKPOINT: Deadline to submit estimated completion date declaration</p> <p>Schools and colleges must submit a declaration to confirm all the estimated completion dates are correct. The declaration will be available to submit from 1 March.</p>
From 1 May onwards	<p>Schools and colleges check unit achievements are on track and resolve issues</p> <p>Schools and colleges use the Cambridge Technicals Progress Tracker to identify students who are not eligible to receive a result based on the current achievements. This allows potential issues to be resolved where possible.</p> <p>Students without the required unit achievements will not receive a result by results day.</p>
15 May	<p>Deadline to arrange final planned moderation visit</p> <p>Schools and colleges can have two free visits per subject area each academic year. The final planned visit must take place by 30 June.</p>
15 June	<p>Deadline to submit claims before final planned moderation visit</p> <p>Students without claims will show as ineligible within the Progress Tracker. Claims must be submitted at least two weeks before the moderation visit and must be submitted by 15 June at the latest.</p>
30 June	<p>Deadline for final planned moderation visits</p> <p>Moderation visits must be completed by this date. Visits after 30 June put students at risk of not receiving results by results day.</p>
10 August	<p>Release of results for June 2026 series</p> <p>Qualification results issued to schools and colleges alongside results for June 2026 series examined units. Results can be issued to students as soon as they are released although schools and colleges may wish to issue them at the same time as A Level results.</p>
13 August	<p>Results day</p> <p>The day when students will expect to receive their qualification results alongside results for the June 2026 series examined units.</p>
