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## Introduction

Our examiners' reports are produced to offer constructive feedback on candidates' performance in the examinations. They provide useful guidance for future candidates.

The reports will include a general commentary on candidates' performance, identify technical aspects examined in the questions and highlight good performance and where performance could be improved. The reports will also explain aspects which caused difficulty and why the difficulties arose, whether through a lack of knowledge, poor examination technique, or any other identifiable and explainable reason.

Where overall performance on a question/question part was considered good, with no particular areas to highlight, these questions have not been included in the report.

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## Unit 1 series overview

### General comments on the paper

The entry size for the January 2025 series was lower than the last four January exam series.

The mean mark achieved by candidates was higher than in both the June and January 2024 series.

The 'achieved' boundary was set at 26, which is higher than the last three series but this matches the 'achieved' boundary from January 2023.

#### Assessment for learning



Centres are always advised to focus not only on the knowledge requirements across the five learning outcomes for this unit but also ensure candidates are familiar with the different assessment styles used in this summative assessment – i.e., linking boxes, true/false, diagram-related questions and select 'three'.

Performance across the learning outcomes this series was fairly well balanced, but candidates performed best in questions aimed at Learning outcome 4 and worst in questions aimed at Learning outcome 1.

### Learning outcome 1: Questions 1, 2, 11, 17, 24, 29, 34, 35, 40

This learning outcome covers knowledge of hardware components. LO1 is one of the weightier LOs within the unit and as a result centres should spend more time with their candidates to develop knowledge around types of computer systems, networks, connectivity methods, topologies, network protocols, computer components, devices, and fault diagnosis.

Candidates' overall performance this series was not as strong in this learning outcome in comparison to other learning outcomes.

Candidates performed particularly well in Questions 1, 2 and 29 but, as mentioned above, candidates struggled to identify how memory components are used.

## Learning outcome 2: Questions 3, 7, 10, 12, 14, 16, 21, 22, 25, 30

This learning outcome requires candidates to know about software components. It is the highest weighted learning outcome in the examination with 25% of questions assessing this area of knowledge.

Overall performance from candidates in this learning outcome was reasonable. Candidates performed particularly well on a question which required them to be familiar with the components of multimedia and also performed well in Questions 12, 14 and 16.

### Misconception



Candidates need to familiarise themselves with the limitations of mobile apps.

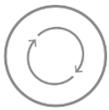
## Learning outcome 3: Questions 4, 5, 8, 27, 28, 31, 36, 38

This learning outcome covers knowledge of installing and upgrading hardware and software. Candidates' overall performance on this learning outcome was a little better than on Learning outcome 1, but not as good as on the other three learning outcomes.

Candidates performed particularly well on Questions 4 and 27, which both related to organisational health and safety responsibilities, and also on Question 8.

Questions 31 and 36 were not answered as well as the other questions on this learning outcome.

### Assessment for learning



It would benefit candidates to be more familiar with the order of procedures for completing an upgrade, including when user acceptance testing happens.

## Learning outcome 4: Questions 6, 9, 13, 15, 18, 23, 33, 39

This LO requires candidates to know about the use of the world wide web.

Candidates' overall performance was strongest in this learning outcome. Most candidates correctly answered a question asking them to identify that the purpose of a device shown was activity tracking and candidates performed particularly well on Questions 6, 9 and 23.

A question asking candidates to identify three benefits of online shopping was not answered as well as other questions on this learning outcome. However, there were no questions for which the overall performance of candidates was particularly lacking.

## Learning outcome 5: Questions 19, 20, 26, 32, 37

This learning outcome covers knowledge of the benefits of using IT in business. This is the lowest weighted learning outcome in the examination. Candidates performed well in this area.

Candidates performed particularly well in a question which asked them to identify how IT can support collaboration and sharing. A question in which candidates needed to identify a description of customer engagement in social media was not answered as well as other questions.
