



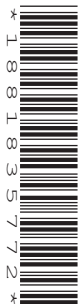

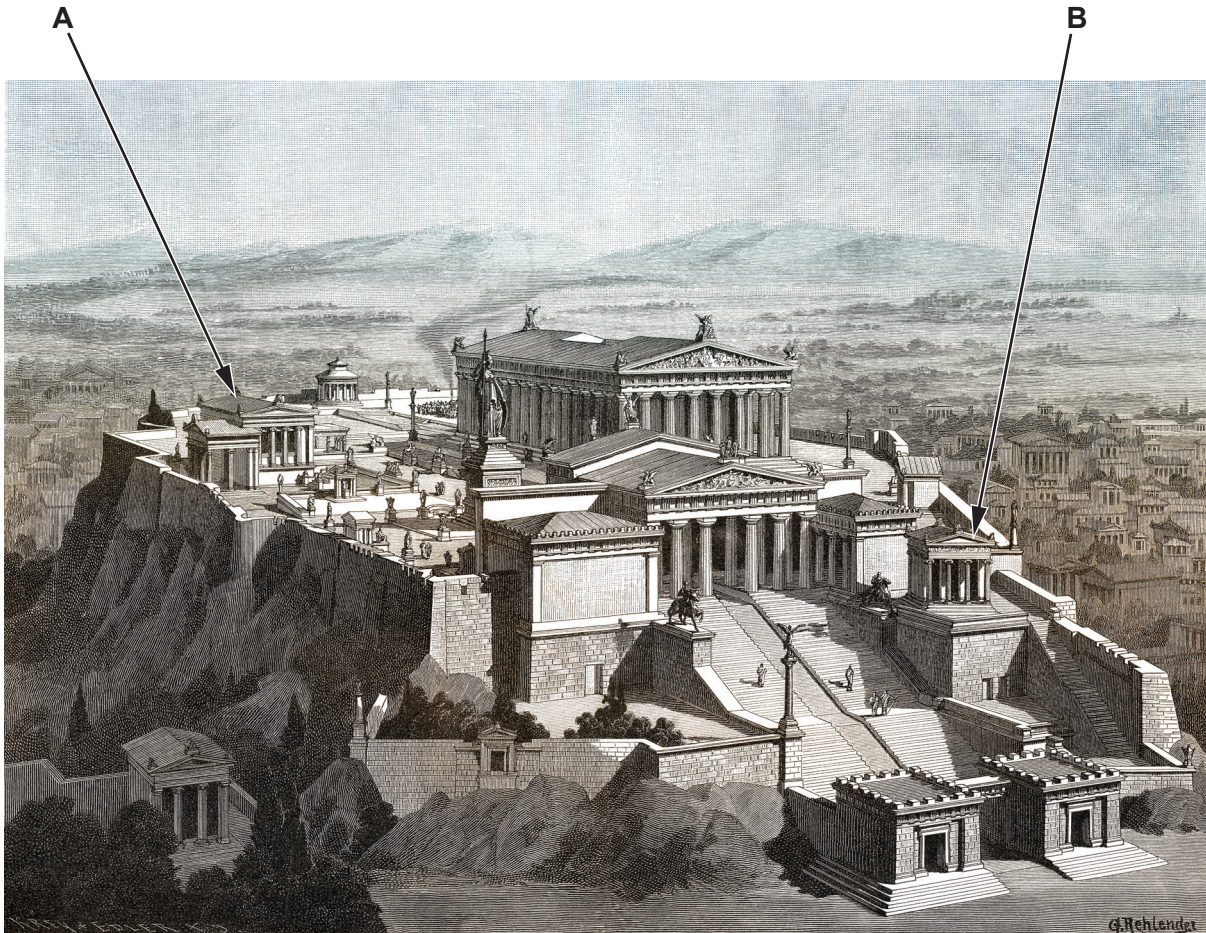

- 5** Name **one** of Socrates' students who wrote about his beliefs. [1]

- 7*** 'Traditional beliefs in the Olympian gods and goddesses were beginning to decline in Athens by the time of Socrates' trial.'
