Fees for late entries, withdrawals, entry amendments and transfer of candidates



We rely on centres to make their entries promptly and accurately. Entries made after the deadline can disrupt tight schedules and affect the delivery of your results. We therefore charge late entry fees, both to recover the costs associated with the extra processing and to encourage prompt entries. We will only refund late entry fees in exceptional circumstances.

Entry fee	The fee charged for each student entered for a unit or qualification.
Certification entry	Confirms an overall grade is expected for ungraded qualifications. No fee or late fees apply.
Late entry (Stage 1) fee	Charged after the entry deadline. You pay the original entry fee and a late fee of the same amount.
Very late entry (Stage 2) fee	Charged after the late entry (Stage 1) deadline. You pay the original entry fee and a very late fee of twice the original entry fee.
Pirate entry	When a student takes an exam without an entry. We charge very late entry fees.
Option change	Changes to moderation method, carry-forward option or exam paper option. There is no fee for moderation method or carry forward changes: changes are charged then fully refunded. For exam paper option changes, late or very late fees apply to the new option, and the original entry option is refunded until the withdrawal-with-refund deadline above.
Tier change	Changes the exam tier, e.g. Foundation to Higher. We only charge Stage 2 very late entry fees. Stage 1 late entry fees do not apply. The original entry fee is refunded for all tier changes.
Withdrawn entry	Removal of a submitted entry. After the withdrawal-with-refund deadline, you can apply for a refund for medically unfit, bereaved or deceased candidates up to one week before results are issued. Send a medical certificate for medically unfit candidates, or a letter on centre-headed paper for bereaved or deceased candidates, to entries@ocr.org.uk .
Resit	For Extended Project resits in June after a January entry, the entry deadline is extended from 21 February to 4 April. Entries from 5 April are charged using the late and very late entry deadlines above.
