



Scenario

Paul is attending college and wants to gain his level 3 extended diploma in ICT Systems and Principles for IT Professionals. Whilst at school, he successfully achieved the level 2 Diploma in ICT Systems and Principles for IT Practitioners with the following units.

Mandatory units include:

- Unit 1 Customer Care level 2 (6 credits)
- Unit 3 Organisation and Planning of own Workload level 2 (4 credits)

Optional units will include:

- Unit 47 compTIA A+ Essentials level 2 (10 credits)
- Unit 48 compTIA A+ Practical Application level 2 (10 credits)
- Unit 9 Hardware Installation level 2 (4 credits)
- Unit 19 Systems Architecture level 2 (6 credits)

For the extended diploma Paul will need to achieve 72 credits of which 44 must be at level 3.

He will need to achieve the following mandatory units:

- Unit 2 Customer Care level 3 (7 credits)
- Unit 4 Management and Prioritisation of own Schedule (8 credits)

Optional units will include:

- Unit 43 CISCO IT Essentials part 1 level 2 (10 credits)
- Unit 72 CISCO IT Essentials part 2 level 3 (10 credits)
- Unit 70 CISCO Exploration Network Fundamentals level 3 (10 credits)
- Unit 71 CISCO Exploration Routing protocols and concepts level 3 (10 credits)
- Unit 47 compTIA A+ Essentials level 2 (10 credits)
- Unit 48 compTIA A+ Practical Application level 2 (10 credits)

Total 75 credits

The college has used his previous highlighted achievements which exempts Paul from repeating the already accredited units for accreditation towards the extended diploma.

Evidence requirements for any unit where exemptions are claimed would need to be produced as an endorsed copy of the certificate identifying the units achieved. This will also include any vendor units.
