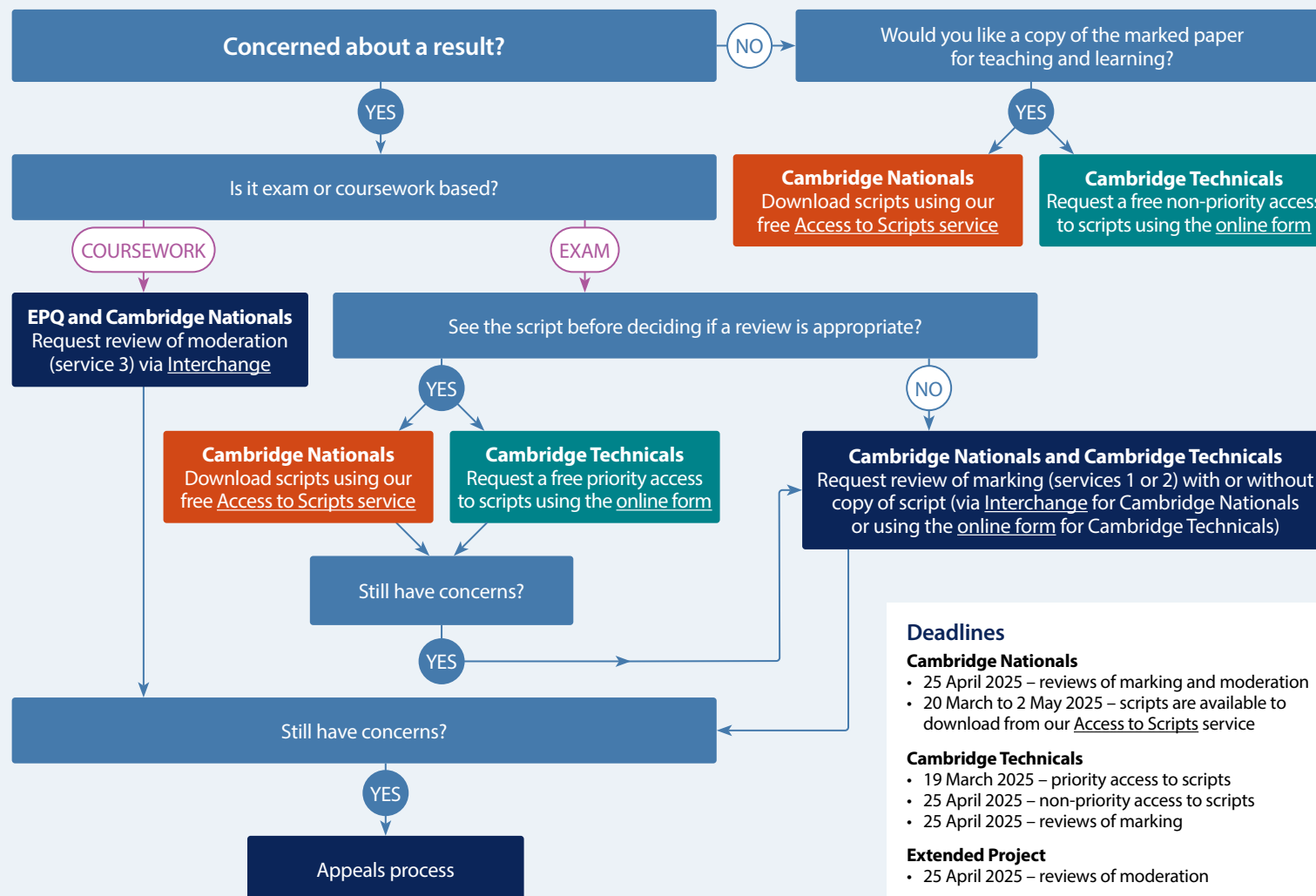


OCR's *post-results* services and fees: January 2025 series

There are a number of options available if you have a concern about a result.

Here's a quick guide to your main options: requesting one of our **reviews of results** or getting hold of a copy of a marked exam paper (**access to scripts**). If you still have a concern after this, we offer an appeals service. Students should speak to a teacher or exams officer at their school or college about post-results services.

- Cambridge Technicals**
- 19 March 2025 – priority access to scripts
 - 25 April 2025 – non-priority access to scripts
 - 25 April 2025 – reviews of marking
- Extended Project**
- 25 April 2025 – reviews of moderation

Our services explained

Access to scripts – Cambridge Nationals

A PDF copy of the original marked script (free) to help you decide whether to request a review of marking and to support teaching and learning. Exams officers can download copies of scripts using our on-demand service, [Access to Scripts](#), accessed via our single sign-on service, My Cambridge – visit [our website](#) for step-by-step instructions.

Service 2a and 2b Review of marking for Cambridge Technicals Performing Arts units where an access to scripts is not available (see [our website](#)).

Service 3 Review of moderation (£301.50) – Review of the original moderation to ensure assessment criteria have been fairly, reliably, and consistently applied.

Access to scripts – Cambridge Technicals

Priority (free) – A PDF copy of the original marked script to help you decide whether to request a review.

Copy of script A PDF copy of the reviewed script (free) is available after the review or clerical re-check has been completed.

Non-priority for teaching and learning (free) – As priority but not guaranteed to be delivered before the review deadline.

Missing and incomplete results (MIR)

Service 1 Clerical re-check (£11.50) of all procedures leading to the issue of a result.

An investigation to check if a result indicator – no result (X), partial absence (#) or pending (Q) – has been wrongly applied (**free**).

Service 2 Review of marking (£65.25) to ensure the agreed mark scheme has been applied correctly. If you are concerned about a group of candidates, you should submit requests for
