# Guide to stages on Entry 1 Achievement Continuum covered by E1 units

This guide shows the stages of Entry 1 Achievement Continuum covered by each Entry 1 unit in the OCR Life and Living Skills qualifications. This will enable you to easily identify which units may be suitable for your Entry 1 learners. Please note that this is only a guide and the units can be achieved outside the range shown.

Each stage of the Achievement Continuum below has been numbered, this numbering system has been used in the table to show the stages of the Achievement Continuum covered by each unit.

### The Entry 1 Achievement continuum

#### The 10 stages – Summary description

- Encounter Characterised by presence and reflex responses
- 2 Early awareness Characterised by fleeting attention and inconsistent responses
- 3 Interest Characterised by more consistent and differentiated reactions
- 4 Supported participation Characterised by co-operation and engagement
- 5 Active involvement

Characterised by recognition, anticipation and proactive responses

6 Development

Characterised by remembered responses and intentional communication

7 Exploration

Characterised by concentration, recall and observation

## 8 Initiation

Characterised by established responses and conventional communication

9 Consolidation

Characterised by the formation of skills, knowledge, concepts and understandings

#### 10 Application

Characterised by the application of skills, knowledge, concepts and understandings
